

## **Summer school on the impact of health systems on sustainable development of local communities, Ljubljana, Slovenia, from 4th – 5th of September 2019**

In partnership with the WHO Europe, the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Slovenia and National Institute of Public Health in Slovenia, the Centre for Health and Development Murska Sobota is organising a public health **Summer school on the impact of health systems on sustainable development of local communities**. The School will be held in Ljubljana from 4th to 5th of September 2019 in **City Hotel** and is open to international participants around the world.

### **Scope and purpose**

As WHO collaborating centre for cross-sectoral approaches to health and development, Centre for health and development Murska Sobota organizes public health schools and short trainings with the aim to increase capacity for understanding, measuring, and acting on inequalities in health and social determinants of health in central, eastern and south-eastern Europe since 2009. The public health school is open to international participants around the world as well. Essential element in our work is cross-sectoral approach to health and development. This year's summer school focus is on researching the potentials of health systems operations and maximising economic and social impact on sustainable development of communities with a goal to promote health equity and wellbeing of population.

### **The objectives of this year's summer school are:**

- To show the economic footprint of health systems on national and regional economies in selected WHO EURO states
- To discuss the potential of health systems in planning and implementing measures of sustainable development in local communities
- Providing opportunity for exchange of know-how, good practices and innovative approaches on maximising economic and social impacts of health systems in local communities

**Working language will be English or translated in English**, since the summer school is an international event.

### **Participation fee**

There is no participation fee for summer school, snacks and coffee during breaks, lunches and two dinners are covered by the organizers. Participants need to cover their accommodation and travel to the venue.
