Basic strategies for health promotion

- **Advocate:** Health is a resource for social and developmental means.
- **Enable:** Health equity must be reached where individuals must become empowered to control the determinants that affect their health, such that they are able to reach the highest attainable quality of life.
- **Mediate:** Health promotion cannot be achieved by the health sector alone but in collaboration with all sectors of government (social, economic, etc.) as well as independent organizations (media, industry, etc.).
